<p>Keep Copying</p> <p>Write your words out three times each. Use different colours if you want to.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"> spelling spelling spelling </p>	<p>Picture This</p> <p>Include each of your words in a funny picture that makes you think of the word.</p> 
<p>Make the Headlines</p> <p>Cut letters out of newspapers or magazines and stick them onto paper to make the words in your list.</p> 	<p>Build a Sentence</p> <p>Write each of your words in a sentence. See if you can build your sentences into a story.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">One day a huge spelling monster came to my town and ate all the words!</p>
<p>Build a Pyramid</p> <p>Make a pyramid using the letters in your words.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> w wo wor word words </p>	<p>Capital Idea</p> <p>Write your words three times, each in capital letters.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"> SPELLING SPELLING SPELLING </p>
<p>Create with Colour</p> <p>Write your words with each letter in a different colour or write them with all the vowels in blue and all the consonants in red.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"> spelling spelling </p>	<p>Learn your ABC</p> <p>Write your words in alphabetical order, then rewrite them in order of the second letter, third letter and so on.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"> my words spelling spelling words my </p>
