# Week commencing 6th July

On Monday the children will find out who their new teacher will be and which class they will be in. #### Literacy

This week we are learning all about worms! Watch Mrs Head's assembly video all about worms to find out some new facts. Have a go at making a fact book all about worms.

As we are finding out which class we are in this week we are going to be writing a letter to our new teacher. In your letter you could tell your new teacher what you like doing, what you are good at, what you are looking forward to doing in year one and ask any questions you may have.

At the beginning of the year all the children completed an 'All about me' flower. Now the year is coming to an end we would like to children to complete another one so we can compare what has changed. Attached is the 'All about me' flower.

# Maths

In maths this week we are revising two topics from earlier in the year — weight and 3D shape.

As part of our weight learning we are going to be weighing 5 different objects and putting them in order of weight. If you have digital scales the children can compare the number on the scales or you could make some balance scales using a coat hanger.

For 3D shapes see if the children can identify the following shapes: cube, cuboid, cylinder, square based pyramid and sphere. They could go on a shape hunt around the house to see how many objects they can find that are this shape. Attached is a 3D shape hunt sheet.

## **Topic**

As we have learnt about many different bugs we are going to make our own clay bug. We are looking at the art work of 'Bitossi' and different types of bug sculptures before designing and making our ow bug from clay. If you do not have clay at home you could use playdough or junk modelling.

As part of our week all about worms we are thinking about what worms can and can't eat. Have a go at finding pictures of different foods in a magazine or drawing food in two columns – 'Worm can eat' and 'worms can't eat'.

#### **Phonics**

This week we are practising writing our phase 2 and 3 tricky words. We are also learning how to read and write polysyllabic words by covering the end of the word up and then reading the second part of the word. We have also been identifying how many syllables different words have, I wonder how many syllables are in your name?
