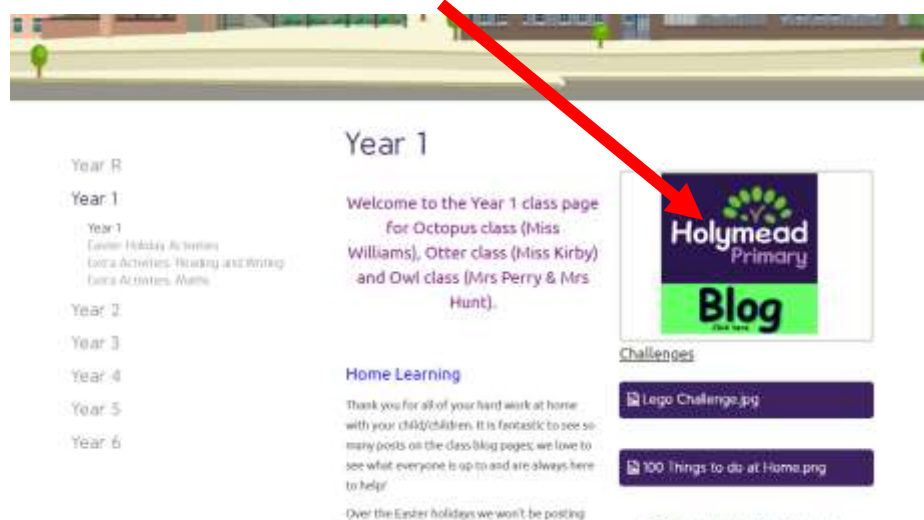


How to access the class blog pages on a tablet or computer:

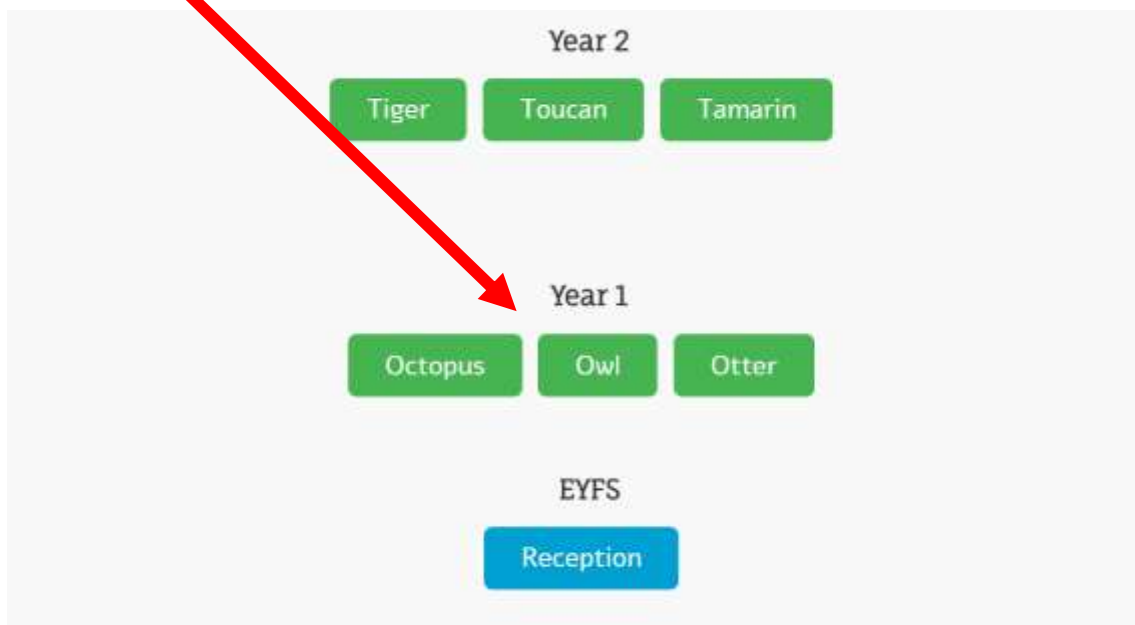
1. Go to the school webpage: <http://www.holymeadp.bristol.sch.uk/web>
2. Click on the Year Groups tab at the top and choose Year One.



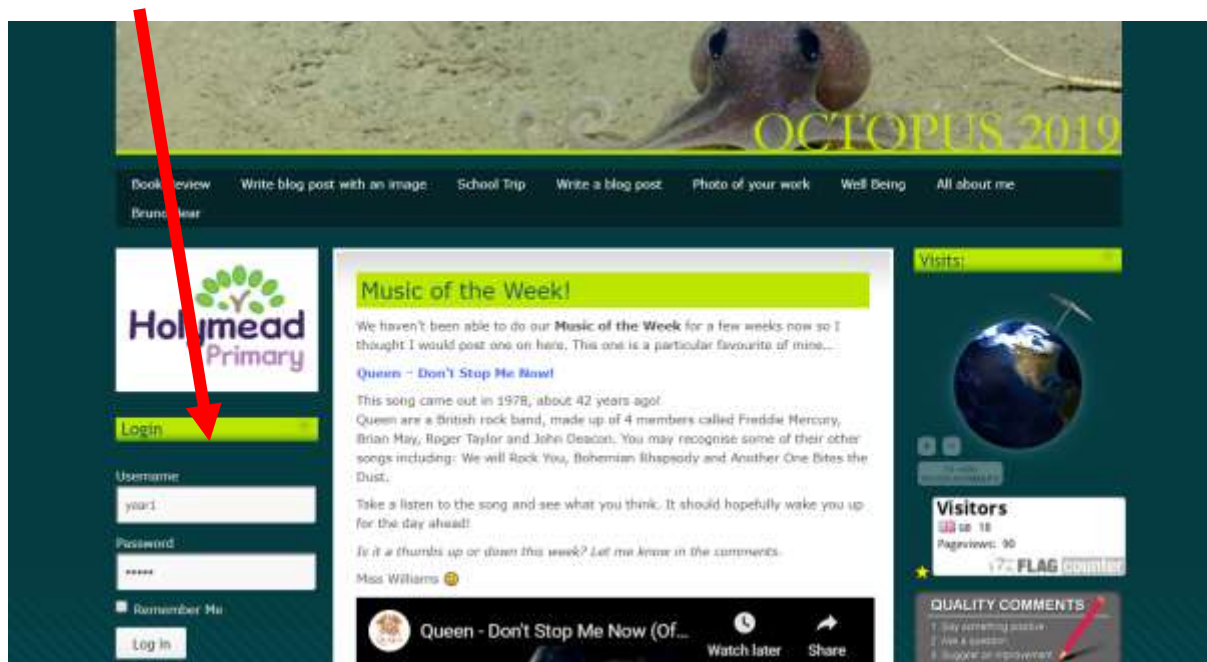
3. Click on the Holymead Primary Blog link.



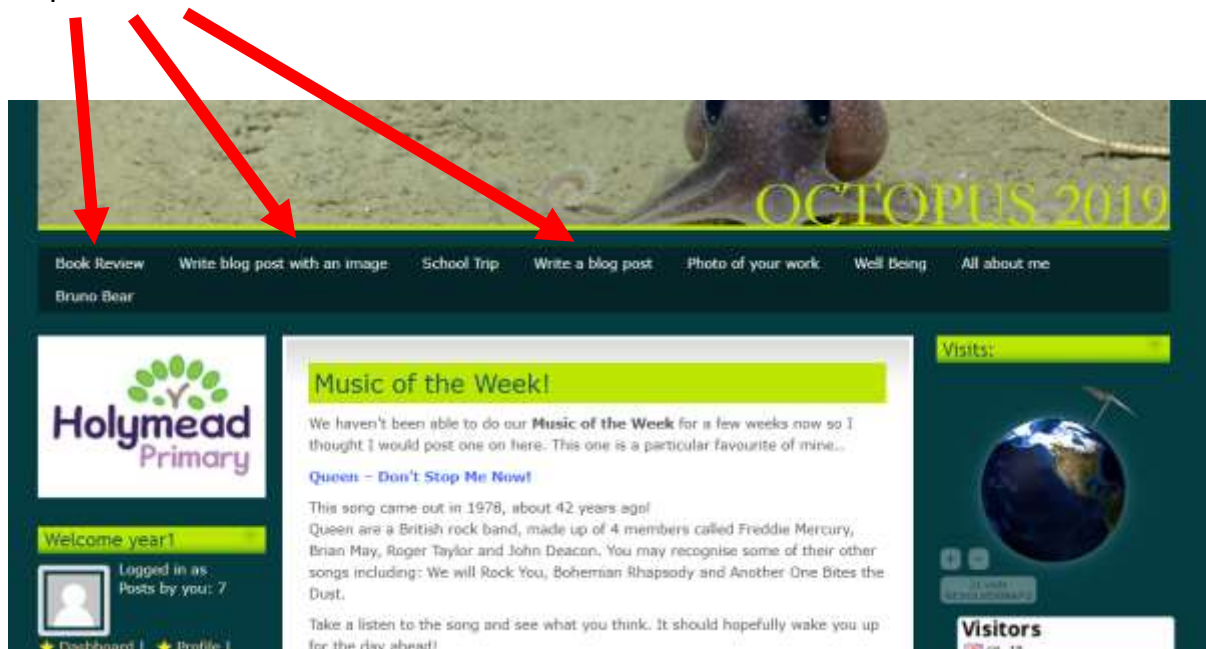
4. Scroll down and select your child's class.



5. You can log in using the username **year1** and the password **year1**.



6. You can now select from the tabs at the top to choose what you would like to post.



7. Fill in the form. Include your first name at the end of your post so that your teacher knows who the post is from and press submit. **Remember to not include any surnames.**

Write blog post with an image

Write a blog post with image uploader

Use this form to write a blogpost for your class blog. All posts will be reviewed by your class teacher before being published.

What is the title of your blog post? *

Before you click submit, make sure you have reviewed your post and checked that the spelling and punctuation are correct and that it makes sense.

What is your username? *

Write your username. e.g. j7jane

Add some tags *

Tags are labels that you attach to your blog post. For example, if you are writing a story, your tag could be "story". If you are writing about a subject, your tag could be "science" or "poetry" or "The Romans". Add as many tags as you want. Tags should be added without quote marks and separated by commas. For example: history, Romans, slaves

Upload an image for your blogpost

IMPORTANT: When choosing an image to upload to your blogpost you must make sure that you have permission to do so. All images uploaded must either have been taken by you or the copyright licence on the image allows you to upload it to a school blog. If you are not sure, check with your teacher.
