Things to Bring

- A small rucksack - in which the children will bring their reading records, reading and library books. Book bags are not necessary.

- No pencil cases.

- Water bottle - labelled with your child's name.

- Snack - fruit for break (please this keep this separate from your child's packed lunch).

- Please ensure all jumpers/ cardigans are clearly labelled with your child's name.

Things to Bring - PE

- **PE kit is to be worn to school on PE days** (Tuesday & Wednesday).

PE kit should be the following:

• Dark purple tee shirt (school logo or plain)

• Plain black shorts. In cold weather - black or dark grey leggings, tracksuit or jogging bottoms. No camouflage, no patterns, no stripes, no logos.

- · School sweat shirt (no other tops)
- · Plain black daps or trainers (no coloured trainers)

As white and purple polo shirts are already part of school uniform these can also be worn on PE days. No football shirts or other kits unless they are the school team kits.

School Day

The school day for Year 3 will begin at **8:40** am and finishes at **3:15** pm.

You can bring your child onto the playground on the Junior site and they will either be let in through their classroom door (Turtle and Tawny Owl class) or let in through the door to the middle hall (Tree Frog Class).

<u>Year 3 curriculum</u>

- Recorders. In Year 3 all children take part in weekly recorder lessons. Recorders are provided by the school.

- Swimming: Term 3/4. More information will be given at the end of Term 2.

- Each class has a weekly library visit. In addition to their leveled reading books, children have the opportunity to borrow a book from the library. This needs to be in school every Wednesday so that the children can renew it or exchange it.

<u>Year 3 curriculum</u>

- After school clubs. There will be opportunities for children to participate in a range of paid/ staff run clubs during the year including multi sports and cricket.

<u>Support at home</u>

- Please read at home at least 3 times a week and record this in your child's reading diary.
- Ensure your child is completing regular times tables practise using TT Rockstars.
- Homework will be handed out on Thursday and due in on Tuesday.
- Please support your child to learn their homework spellings. These are tested once a week. All the spellings go out at the beginning of each term.

<u>Communication</u>
