



Guidance about Seesaw

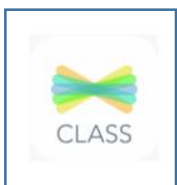
Seesaw is our new online learning platform for Years 1 and 2. It will be used to set some homework, and to share amazing things that the children do at home. In the event of any school / bubble closure, it will be used to set, share and comment on your child's work.

You can access your child's journal anytime via iOS app, Android app, Kindle Fire app, or on the website using other smartphones and computers

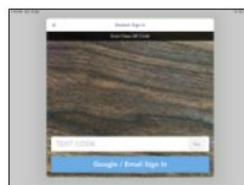
How do I log into Seesaw?



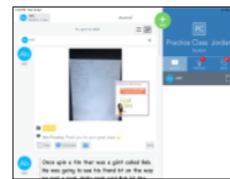
1. Download the class app



2. Tap on I'm a student



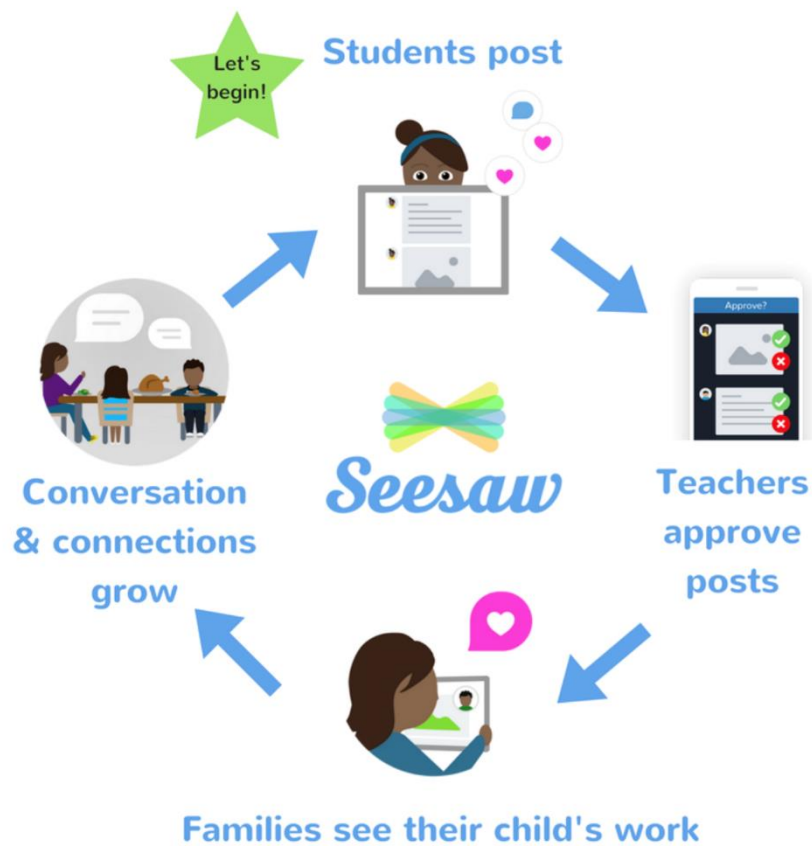
3. Scan your class QR code; enter your class text code



4 It will bring up your home journal screen. Click on the green +



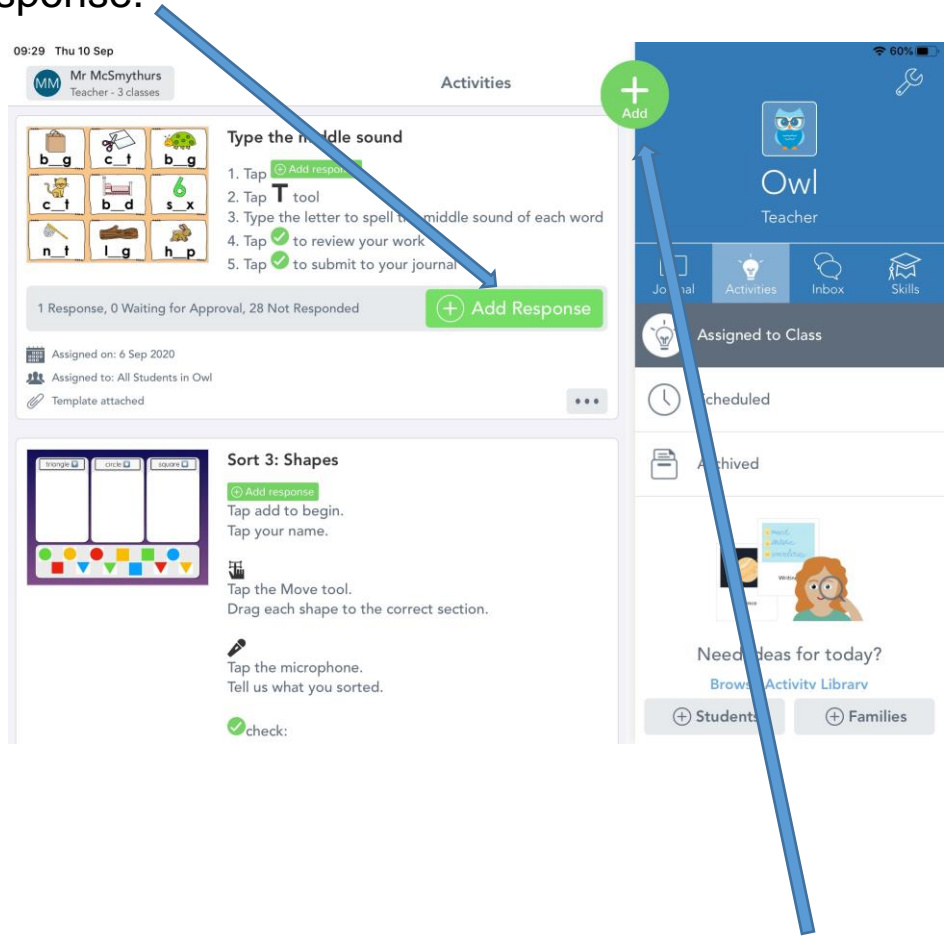
5 Tap on the tool you want to use and add your work.



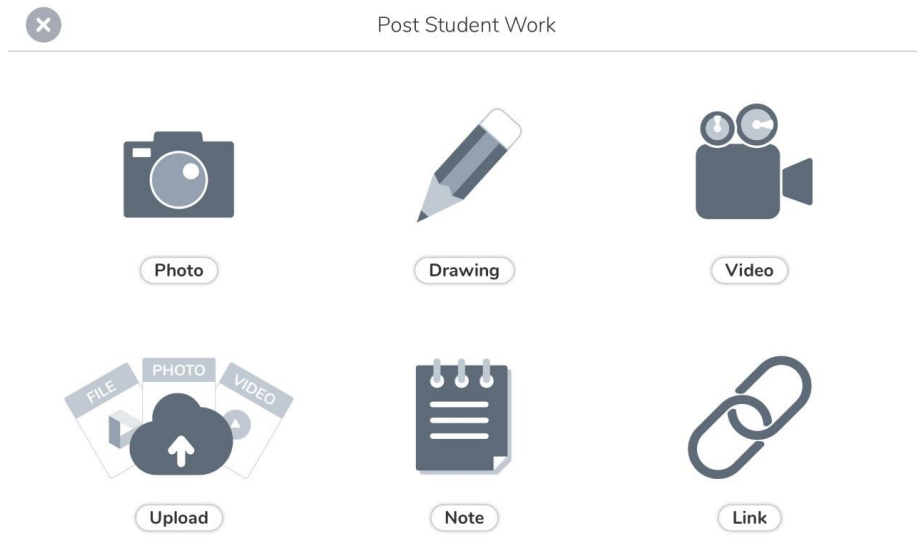
All posts are approved by the teacher and will be saved in your child's journal, and some will be published to the class page for other pupils to see as well. Your child's journal can be downloaded at the end of the academic year.

Your child will get notifications when new tasks are set, and see what they need to complete by clicking the Activities button. We recommend turning off notifications on your device.

Children will be set activities or tasks by their class teacher. They can click add response.



To complete a post of their own, children can click the ADD button and this screen will appear.



Children can take photos and videos in the app, complete drawing tasks, write on worksheets on screen set by the teacher, and upload any photos or documents made at home.
