

### Year 3 Expectations

By the end of Year 3, your child should know their 2, 5, 10, 3, 4, 8 and 11 times tables fluently. They need to know their multiplication and division facts linked to these tables.

### Weekly & termly focus

Each week, we will focus on a particular table for one starter session.

Twice a term, we will focus on a specific table for a whole week. We will be focusing on highlighting known number facts (0x, 1x, 2x, 5x, 10). We will also encourage children to reverse number facts to make them easier to learn. For example  $5 \times 3$  is  $3 \times 5$ .

### TT Rockstars

Your children are expected to complete a weekly session on TT Rockstars. They need to complete at least 5 games in the 'Garage'.

Home practise is just as important as school practise.

These tables have been set by TT Rockstars after assessing them.

Gig sessions will pop up to assess the children periodically. They will be set new times tables to learn based on this assessment.

To encourage frequent use of TT Rockstars at home, we have created posters that are displayed in our classrooms. We will be monitoring TT Rockstars each week. 1 child will be chosen for 'Star of the Week' for making good progress/ putting in great effort. 1 child will be chosen for the 'Highest Earner' for playing the highest number of games.

### Teaching

- Use of the counting stick
- Related facts
- Worded problems
- Missing number questions
- Visual representations e.g. arrays, groups, pictures.
- Times Table games
