Reminder- 'Holidays in term time are not normally authorised.' 'Penalty Notices (fines) may be used where absence is unauthorised,' Education Welfare Service.

Holidays should not be taken in term time so do not be surprised if your request is not authorised and you are fined. Holidays need to be taken in school holidays not during term time.

If you have an exceptional reason for needing to take your child out of school during term time you will need to fill in a leave of absence form from the office stating the exceptional reason eg to see a terminally ill grandparent or attend a close relative's wedding. These will be kept as evidence should a penalty notice or court case ensue.

Please note requests for taking children out of school for exceptional reasons must be made in advance of taking children out. Leave of absence cannot be authorised after you return and therefore will be marked as unauthorised. 4 days (8 half days) of unauthorised absences can mean a penalty notice (fine) is issued.

These are short 5-10 minute

appointments so please be prepared to leave promptly. If you need additional time to discuss any further issues please arrange to meet teachers on another evening after school. These meetings are not suitable for children and there are no crèche facilities. Thank you.

Senco Meetings: Mrs Cole will be available to talk to parents about their children's progress, if they have special needs. She will be on the KS2 site on 16^{th} November from 3.30-5.30. To pick a 10 minute slot please call the office when you have your appointment time for parents' evening.

Please note there will be no staff run clubs on evenings when there are Parents' Evenings because staff are obviously meeting parents!



Christmas Carol Service- as you know we are a very large primary school and being split over two sites means we don't have a large enough hall to ever get together in one place. Our Carol Concert at St Cuthbert's has become a bit of a Christmas tradition where we all get together and this year we are fortunate enough to have been welcomed back on 2nd December. Unfortunately (if that's the right word!) we are such a large community that the church was absolutely packed last year just with children and a few adult helpers so we are unable to invite parents to come and join the service.
