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| Place Value | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can identify the number of tens and ones in a number i.e 76 has 7 tens and 6 ones using apparatus if needed. I can read and write numbers correctly up to 100. |
| Times Tables | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can count in twos, fives and tens from 0. I can count in groups of two, fives and tens to solve problems e.g count the number chairs when in rows of fives by counting in groups of five. |
| Arithmetic | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can add two digit numbers and one digit numbers where the answer does not cross into the next ten e.g $23+5$. I can subtract two digit numbers and one digit numbers where the answer does not cross into the next ten e.g $28-5$. I can add and subtract using apparatus and drawing pictures. I know number bonds within twenty e.g $2+7=9$, $4+5=9$ etc. I can use my number bonds and related subtraction to help solve problems e.g $9=7+?$ I can double numbers below 20. I can halve even numbers below 20. I can read, write and interpret number sentences involving $+ - =$ |
| Fractions | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can identify $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of a shape. I can identify $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of a quantity. |
| Geometry: properties of shapes | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can recognise and name some common 2D and 3D shapes. |
| Measures | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can compare and begin to record mass, weight, length and time. I can identify the value of British coins. I can say the days of the week and months of the year. |
