## Holymead Primary Parent/Carer Questionnaire <u>Year 6</u> Results 2019 What do these results tell us?

It's been a few years since we sent out this particular survey so I looked back to see if there has been any change over time. Whilst the great majority of you ticked 'agree' with the things we were doing well in 2016, what is really pleasing to see is that this year more parent/carers across the whole school have ticked 'agree strongly' indicating the school has travelled in a very positive direction since then. Of course where things could be better we are taking on board your suggestions and trying to improve where we can.

## Things you think the school is doing well.

Most of you feel the school:

- is approachable (Q1) and your children enjoy school (Q5)
- has high expectations of your child in both work and behaviour (Q3, 6, 8, 11)
- has improved in how it deals with conflicts between children (Q12)
- has good teaching (Q10)
- offers a broad and balanced curriculum with many extra- curricular activities including off-site visits and clubs (Q7, 9). It's good to hear that despite what you may read in the national news, parents recognise that Holymead has always maintained a broad curriculum. - encourages respect of each others' cultures and values (Q13). As a Unicef Rights Respecting School it's good to hear parents feel we encourage this.
- has a good transition programme to help children settle in well (Q15)
- is well led and managed (Q16)
- is improving maintenance and re-decoration (Q19).

## Comments:

- (Q4) regarding the amount of homework; 2 parents disagreed; of these one said there was too much and one said there was not enough. Having reviewed homework in response to previous surveys we feel we have the balance about right now.
- (Q18) Responses to this question indicate parents feel governors communicate more information to parents now than they have done previously. However, governors are always looking to improve so I will pass on your feedback.
