of funny books! The challenge is live now from June to September.

## How to take part

Children sign up at <u>Silly Squad</u> and create their own profile with the assistance of an adult. They set their own reading goals, and are encouraged to read anything that makes them happy – fiction, information books, comics, jokes. Children are encouraged to read library books, digital eBooks and listen to eAudio books or read books they already have at home. Each time they finish a book; they add it to their profile and write a review. Children are rewarded with fun activities and incentives along the way, such as online badges, games and videos. When they complete the challenge, they receive a downloadable certificate.
