COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE

If a parent/carer has a complaint about the school, please contact your child's teacher in the first instance. If your child's teacher is unable to answer your query, or you are unhappy with the response, the matter should be referred to the Head Teacher in writing. If you are still not satisfied with the response, then a written complaint should be made to the Chair of Governors, Mr Wright, c/o Holymead Primary School, Wick Road, Brislington, Bristol BS4 4HB. The governing body will then investigate your complaint.

If you wish to escalate a complaint you will need to write to the Secretary of State for Education,

This will be the final stage in the complaint handling process.
