Composition	 I can plan my writing by discussing and recording ideas. I can use paragraphs in my writing. I can set the scene by describing characters, the setting or building up a plot. I can evaluate and edit my work to make it better. I can proof read my work for spelling and punctuation errors.
Grammar & Vocabulary	 I can use conjunctions to join to sentences (and, so, but because etc.) I can use the present and past tense correctly. I can choose nouns or pro-nouns appropriately to avoid repetition in my writing. I can use fronted adverbials to sequence my writing (first, next, then, after etc.) I know what a noun, adjective, verb and adverb is and can use them in my writing.
Punctuation	 I can use capital letters and full stops in my sentence. I can use question marks and exclamation marks correctly. I can use commas in a list. I can use commas after fronted adverbials, adverb openers and subordinate clause openers. I can punctuate speech correctly. I can use apostrophes in contractions such as don't.
Handwriting	 I can sit the letters on the lines in my book with the use of ascenders and descenders. I can ensure my letters are of consistent size. I know which letters to and not to join in my writing.
