School Day

The school day for Year 3 will begin at **8:40** am and finishes at **3:20** pm.

The register will be taken at **8:50** am.

You can bring your child onto the playground on the Junior site and they will either be let in through their classroom door (Tree Frog & Tawny Owl) or let in through the door to the middle hall (Turtle Class).



Things to Bring

- A small rucksack - in which the children will bring their reading records, reading and library books. Book bags are not necessary.
- **No** pencil cases.
- Water bottle - **labelled with your child's name.**
- Snack - fruit for break (**please this keep this separate from your child's packed lunch**).
- **Please ensure all jumpers/cardigans/fleeces are clearly labelled with your child's name.**

Things to Bring - PE

- **PE kit is to be worn to school on PE days** (Tuesday & Wednesday).

PE kit should be the following:

- Dark purple t-shirt (school logo or plain)
- Plain black shorts. In cold weather - black or dark grey leggings, tracksuit or jogging bottoms. No camouflage, no patterns, no stripes, no logos.
- School sweat shirt (no other tops)
- Plain black plimsolls or trainers (no coloured trainers)

As white and purple polo shirts are already part of school uniform these can also be worn on PE days. No football shirts or other kits unless they are the school team kits.

School meals

As your child has now moved into KS2, their universal free school meal entitlement ends and if your child has a school dinner now there will be a charge of **£3.05 per meal**. Dinner money accounts are held on ParentMail and we do ask that this is kept in credit at all times, if your child chooses to have school meals.

If you think your child may be entitled to free school meals and pupil premium, please read the guidance in the ParentMail sent out recently. Free school meals and Pupil Premium get extra funding for our school.

Bristol City Council are asking all parents whose children go to school in Bristol to find out if their child can get free school meals and to register for Pupil Premium funding.

Year 3 curriculum

- **Swimming:** Term 5/6. More information will be given at the end of Term 4.
- Each class has a weekly **library** visit. In addition to their leveled reading books, children have the opportunity to borrow a book from the library. This needs to be in school every Wednesday so that the children can renew it or exchange it.
- **Recorders.** In Year 3, every child will learn the recorder as part of our weekly music lesson. Recorders are provided by the school and stay in school for the duration of the year.
- **After school clubs.** There will be opportunities for children to participate in a range of paid/ staff run clubs during the year including multi sports and cricket.

Support at home

- Please read at home at least 3 times a week and record this in your child's reading diary.
- Ensure your child is completing regular times tables practise using TT Rockstars and completing their times table book. This is marked and set weekly on a Wednesday (please see layout of this on the next slide, the time table will change each week).
- Homework will be handed out on Wednesday and due in on Tuesday via google classroom.
- Please support your child to learn their homework spellings. These are tested once a week. All the spellings go out at the beginning of each term.
